#### Recorder's Ramblings

Merging our database into the Tampa central WebFez has been \*INTERESTING\*. Last October, I noticed that Nobles who had just been created in 2015 were being assessed as being in arrears for \$100 for 2014. It was corrected. Nobles who requested and received demits in 2015 are still being billed for 2016 dues. This too was corrected. It is taking about eight weeks from the date your payment is recorded by us to the date of mailing your dues card from Tampa.

You may sign on to edit your own record for addresses, phone numbers, email, etc. at <a href="https://webfez.shrinenet.org/">https://webfez.shrinenet.org/</a>. At last count, 14 of you have.

The following is a direct quote from WebFez: "Membership Cards are only mailed to the 'Home' or 'Temporary' Address. The 'Temporary' address is used when the mailing date for the card falls between the Start Date and End Date indicated for the address.

The 'Home' address is used when:

- There is no temporary address, or
- The temporary address does not have both a Start Date and an End Date, or
- The End Date of the temporary address has passed.

If there is no address for the Noble, the card will be mailed to the temple."

We had about a dozen dues cards that were mailed to Noble's home addresses during a period when they were not there and were sent to our post box for postage due, because the mass mailing from Tampa does not qualify for automatic forwarding. We have tried to reunite these cards with their owners.

## **Sportsman's Gun Raffle**

The time has come again for the Sportsman's Raffle, scheduled November 12, 2016, from 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm, at the existing Temple. We have an agreement with the prospective buyer, who has agreed if the building ownership should change, Cyprus Shriners may still use the building for the event

The Raffle, at Cyprus Temple, will follow the same schedule as it has in the past. There have been fifteen (15) additional prizes added to the list, which totals fifty (50) prizes this year. There will be additional raffles at the event, just as there has been the last few years.

The manner in which we are doing the raffle has changed this year, which will hopefully improve sales of the raffle tickets. Please review the following description of how the raffle will work, and if you have any questions, please contact me.

The raffle tickets now come in a numbered book, which contains three (3) purple raffle tickets with the prizes on the back of the ticket. The fourth yellow ticket in the book is the Sellers Ticket. If the Seller is able to sell the three purple tickets, the yellow ticket is free to the Seller. There is no limit on the number of Sellers Ticket you accumulate.

The Sellers Ticket entitles the possessor to attend the Raffle Event and makes them eligible for the Sportsman's Raffle prizes. Additionally, the Sellers Ticket will enter the individual listed on the Sellers Ticket Stub in a separate raffle for \$500.00 cash prize. You may enter any number of times, consistent with the number of Raffle Books you have sold.

Please feel free to invite your friends, Firemen, Policemen, or Sportsmen to sell the Raffle Ticket Books. That is the point: to broaden the number of people selling the books.
